Date	Course	Notes
2 Nov	NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting – Instructor Led Training (BOPS-ILT) (8 hrs) \$135.00	The course covers safe handling, the parts and functions of revolvers and semi-automatic pistols, ammunition types and uses, shooting fundamentals, care and maintenance, and shooting skills. Guns and ammunition are furnished for this course. Students receive a Basics of Pistol Shooting Handbook and a NRA Certificate upon Completion. Guns and ammunition are furnished for this course.
9 Nov	Range Safety Officer (8 hrs) \$160.00	This course is for experienced gun handler who can organize and supervise safe shooting activities and range operations. NRA Range Safety Officers must be 21 years of age or older. The Range Safety Officer course consists of: Range Safety Officer's roles and responsibilities, range standard operating procedures, range inspection and range rules, firearm stoppages and malfunctions, and Range Safety Briefings which include emergency procedures. The course also includes role playing of simulated range behaviors. Candidates must also receive 90 percent or better on the written exam.
16 Nov	NRA Basic Rifle (8 hrs) \$130.00	This course includes both classroom and range time learning to shoot rifles. Students learn NRA's rules for safe gun handling; rifle parts and operation; ammunition; shooting fundamentals; range rules; shooting from the bench rest and free arm and arm rest standing positions; cleaning, and continued opportunities for skills development. Students receive a Basics of Rifle Shooting handbook and other information and a course completion certificate upon successful completion of the course material and student exam.
7 Dec	USCCA Defensive Shooting Fundamentals, Level 1 (6 hrs) \$150.00	NOTE: This is an advanced course and potential students should have a good understanding of the legal and moral implications of Concealed Carry. The course uses intuitive teaching methods designed to provide you with efficient training for the most probable types of self-defense situations. This blended learning curriculum and is made up of a DSF-L1 online eLearning module and a follow-on session of live fire exercises on the range. 14 Dec	NRA Home Firearms Safety (4 hrs) \$55.00	This is a non-shooting course designed to teach students the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude for the safe handling and storage of firearms and ammunition in the home. The course is conducted in a classroom. Students are taught NRA's three rules for safe gun handling; primary causes of firearms accidents' firearm parts; how to unload certain action types; ammunition components; cleaning; care; safe storage of firearms in the home; and the benefits of becoming an active participant in the shooting sports. Students receive the NRA Home Firearm Safety handbook and other NRA materials and a course completion certificate.
11 Jan	Metallic Cartridge Reloading (8 hrs) \$120.00	This course will provide beginning reloaders with the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary to safely reload metallic cartridges. The course covers reloading safety, centerfire cartridge components, using the reloading manual, equipment, and the metallic reloading process. Students receive the NRA Guide to Reloading handbook. Students will be awarded a course completion certificate after passing the Basic Reloading Student Exam. All necessary equipment for the class is provided.
18 Jan	Refuse to Be a Victim (4 hrs) \$50.00	The Refuse To Be A Victim® (RTBAV) program is not a firearms or self-defense class. It's a seminar that will help you improve personal safety strategies and will provide you with valuable information that you can apply in every area of your life. The NRA RTBAV seminar covers topics that pertain to both men and women. The information covered is appropriate for young adults, women, the disabled, parents, senior citizens etc. In addition, the RTBAV program materials also include special teaching modules for parents which discusses tips for children ages preschool to college, the handicapped and more.

Upcoming Firearms Instructor Training

NRA Instructor Candidates must attend and have an NRA Basic course completion certificate in the discipline (Pistol, Rifle, etc.) PRIOR to attending the associated NRA Instructor course. Additionally, all candidates must pass a pre-course qualification that evaluates your hand-on proficiency with the fundamentals of safe gun handling and basic marksmanship/shooting skills.

NRA Basic Instructor Training (BIT) is the first required NRA instructor course for new instructor candidates. It is the NRA class that helps candidates, who already have subject matter expertise, learn how to conduct a class the NRA way so that their students earn recognized NRA certification(s). This course teaches you the policies and procedures for becoming an NRA instructor as well as effective teaching methods for training students. BIT is good for 24 months for any additional Instructor ratings; after this period, you must take BIT again to add an additional instructor rating.

Prospective USCCA instructors do not need to complete BIT for USCCA Instructor Certification. The USCCA requires a minimum of three students to conduct a USCCA Instructor Certification class.

These events are designed to provide all the required training to become an NRA Instructor in one weekend starting on Friday with the Basic Shotgun/Rifle Course.
