Friday, 7 February: NRA Basics of Shotgun Shooting (10 hrs) Saturday, 8 February: NRA Basic Instructor Training (6 hrs) Saturday, 8 February and Sunday, 9 February: NRA Basic Shotgun Instructor Training (11 hrs)

<u>**!! NRA INSTRUCTOR COURSE PREREQUISITE!!**</u> Instructor course candidates must have attended the basic class and have a course completion certificate in the discipline they wish to become an instructor for <u>PRIOR</u> to attending this or any NRA Instructor classes.

Basic Instructor Training (BIT) is an NRA pre-requisite for all other NRA Instructor-level courses. BIT teaches instructor candidates what and how NRA presents and sets up a basic NRA course. If this will be your first NRA certified instructor rating, *or if more than 24 months have passed since you last completed BIT* you will be required to take BIT.

Course cost: is \$150 for Basics of Shotgun Shooting, \$125 for BIT, and \$225 for Shotgun Instructor for a total of \$500 if you sign up for all 3 classes. These prices include course materials, firearms usage, ammunition, clays, 7 meals, and accommodations at Camp Comer. It does NOT include NRA processing and certification fee (\$35 for NRA members, \$55 for non-members). Those fees must be paid to the NRA when you establish your online NRA Instructor account after course completion.

A *non-refundable* deposit of \$100.00 is due *no later than* Sunday, 12 January 2020 with the balance due at check-in at Camp Comer. Payment may be made by credit card on the **North Alabama Firearms Training (NAFT)** website, or by personal check or money order. Please make checks/funds payable to **NAFT**. - □ <u>Step 1:</u> Click on the "Camp Comer Instr Reg" link on the left-hand side of the NAFT Homepage.
- Step 2: Choose the courses combination you wish to take using the radio buttons. If you are not already a NRA instructor or have not taken BIT within the last 2 years, you <u>must</u> include BIT. Your total price will be indicated by your selection.
- Step 3. Fill out the information and click on the button at the bottom indicating your deposit payment information. Make your deposit or send us a check according to the directions.





A Pre-Course Qualification must be completed prior to the start of the Shotgun Instructor Course. It is administered in 3 phases as a practical hands-on evaluation. PHASE 1 - LOADING/UNLOADING (varying actions using dummy ammunition) PHASE 2 – CLEARING COMMON STOPPAGES (varying actions using dummy ammunition) PHASE 3 – SHOOTING (Phase 3 may be completed during the Basics of Shotgun Shooting course or done at the beginning of class.)

A description of the pre-qualification exercises along with other course information will be e-mailed to all course registrants.

Successful completion of the NRA Certified Shotgun Instructor Course will result in your obtaining certification as an NRA Basic Shotgun Instructor and will allow you to conduct NRA Basic Shotgun courses. You will also meet BSA requirements to provide shotgun instruction for BSA scout units *in conjunction with an on-site NRA certified Range Safety Officer.* Specific rules for BSA shooting activities will be covered during the course.

Instructor Candidates needing the Basics of Shotgun Shooting (BOSS) Course may arrive either Thursday evening or Friday morning **before 7:30 am**. Following registration, the BOSS course will begin promptly at 8:00 am. Those students who have already completed the NRA BOSS course must bring a copy of their course completion certificate to be eligible to take the Shotgun Instructor Course.

Instructor Candidates needing BIT may arrive either Friday evening or Saturday morning **before 7:30 am**. Following registration, the BIT course will begin promptly at 8:00 am. Those students who have already completed the NRA BIT course must bring a copy of their course completion card to be eligible to take the Shotgun Instructor Course.

Other Instructor Candidates should plan to arrive between noon and 3 pm on Saturday so they can register and go through mandatory pre-qualification testing. For BIT students, the pre-qualification will begin following the completion of the BIT exam.
