25 Jan	NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting  – Instructor Led Training (BOPS-ILT) (8 hrs) \$135.00 (Course Cost Increase in Feb)	The course covers safe handling, the parts and functions of revolvers and semi-automatic pistols, ammunition types and uses, shooting fundamentals, care and maintenance, and shooting skills. Guns and ammunition are furnished for this course. Students receive a Basics of Pistol Shooting Handbook and a NRA Certificate upon Completion. Guns and ammunition are furnished for this course.

7 Mar	NRA Muzzleloading Rifle (10-12 hour) \$155.00	The course is designed to develop the basic knowledge, skills, & attitude essential to the safe & efficient use of a muzzleloading rifle. The course includes: History of Muzzleloading guns, principle parts of flintlock, percussion, and Inline rifles, safe handling rules for Muzzleloading, black power and approved substitutes, and proper safety procedures for loading and storing power. Students lean to shoot from benchrest, cross sticks, and offhand (standing) positions along with how to cleaning black powder rifles. Students receive a copy of the NRA/NMLRA Muzzleloading handbook and a NRA Certificate upon Completion.  Muzzleloading Rifles and other supplies are furnished for this course.

## **Upcoming Firearms Instructor Training**

NRA Instructor Candidates must attend and have an NRA Basic course completion certificate in the discipline (Pistol, Rifle, etc.) PRIOR to attending the associated NRA Instructor course. Additionally, all candidates must pass a pre-course qualification that evaluates your hand-on proficiency with the fundamentals of safe gun handling and basic marksmanship/shooting skills.

NRA Basic Instructor Training (BIT) is the first required NRA instructor course for new instructor candidates. It is the NRA class that helps candidates, who already have subject matter expertise, learn how to conduct a class the NRA way so that their students earn recognized NRA certification(s). This course teaches you the policies and procedures for becoming an NRA instructor as well as effective teaching methods for training students. BIT is good for 24 months for any additional Instructor ratings; after this period, you must take BIT again to add an additional instructor rating.

Prospective USCCA instructors do not need to complete BIT for USCCA Instructor Certification. The USCCA requires a minimum of three students to conduct a USCCA Instructor Certification class.
